# HISTORIC MILESTONES



**1872** - The establishment of Flotilla School, by the Decision of the War Minister, no. **15** from the **17**<sup>th</sup> of November, with the headquarters located in Galati;



**1920** – The reorganization into a complex higher education institution, named the Naval School;



**1956**- Integration within the Romanian polytechnical education system;



1974 – The school receives the symbolic name of "Mircea cel Batran";



1990 - Following the December 1989 revolution, the Marine Institute has been transformed into the "Mircea cel Batran" Naval Academy, awarded with a status of a higher education military institution.




